Rémi was born in April 2014. During his first year of life, it was discovered that he had a heart murmur, but that the situation was not serious and would probably improve over time.

Later, during a follow-up appointment, the heart murmur was gone, but it was discovered that Rémi had fairly advanced subaortic stenosis and surgery was required. Rémi underwent surgery in November 2016 at the Montreal Children's Hospital. The surgery went well, but from the first post-surgery follow-up appointment, it was determined that his condition persisted and that at least another surgery would be necessary in the future because of his growth spurts.

On January 4, 2022, he underwent his second open-heart surgery and despite some complications, Rémi's fine and can't wait to resume his activities such as skiing, cycling, riding his scooter or skateboard!
